

REYC Lymington Meet – Saturday 14th May 2016

The annual Lymington Meet will take place on Saturday 14th May, at the Royal Lymington Yacht Club with racing in the Western Solent.

The format will be similar to previous years with two friendly races, one starting not before 0945 hours and the other at approximately 1330 hours. On this occasion we may be joined by yachts from the Civil Engineers Sailing Club. They are welcome to take part in the racing with either class but will not be eligible for the REYC trophies nor will they take part in the Carlier Trophy Match. The morning race will be for REYC and CEC yachts only. The afternoon race will include a team of three RLYC yachts competing in a friendly inter club match for the Carlier Trophy. The first three yachts home in the morning race will represent the REYC in the match within the race in the afternoon. Note that these are designed to be friendly races, due to insurance restrictions.

There will then be a reception in the Royal Lymington Yacht Club starting at 1815 hours, followed by supper. These are subsidised by the REYC and will be £8 per person for the reception and £28 for the 3 course supper with wine.

The event is very much a social gathering of Sapper sailors, and members are encouraged to bring family and friends. If you are not able to bring a boat, why not come along for the reception and supper?

The Notice of Race (NOR) and entry form are attached. I would appreciate early entries even if the full details are not available. I will need details of your boat, if you wish me to reserve a berth for you at the Lymington Yacht Haven, and numbers for supper by no later than 5 May 2016.

I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at Lymington in May.
